She delivered high quality staff training following this conference and ordered more resources to enable teacher to deliver high quality PE lessons.
Cost of 6 week fencing taster course for all Year 2 children	£1,110	The vast majority of children in Year 2 took up this opportunity and all the children enjoyed learning a new skill. It has inspired several of the children to take this up as a hobby with Chichester Fencing Club.
Cost of PE Leadership time one day per term to review SOW, evaluate and review action plans	£1,000	PE subject leader reviewed and updated the SOW. Sourced and purchased new resources for improving Dance throughout the school. Made new resources i.e. dance and games warm up cards etc. This has enabled staff to have easy access to high quality resources which will increase their confidence and children will receive high quality teaching.
Cost of supply for 2 teachers to attend afternoon rehearsals for West Sussex Dance House Festival at The Alexandra Theatre (Year 2 G&T Dance Club)	£200	14 Year 2 children took part in Dance House 2016 at the Alexandra Theatre in Bognor Regis. The children improved their dance skills and performed on a stage in front of a large audience during the evening and also had the opportunity to be inspired by older children who were also performing in the show. The children were invited back to perform in the highlight show and rose the occasion by improving their dance even more.
Resources to encourage children to be more active at playtimes – PAL tabards and hats, playtime equipment and storage for equipment	£500	Children have more equipment to play with at playtimes and are being supported by the PAL leaders. They are more active and also improving their skills.
Resources to improve and extend PE curriculum throughout the school  – new gym mats, movement table, music for dance, general small apparatus i.e balls, skipping ropes	£1,470.18	This enabled the staff to teach high quality lessons with high quality resources and enabled the children to improve their skills.
